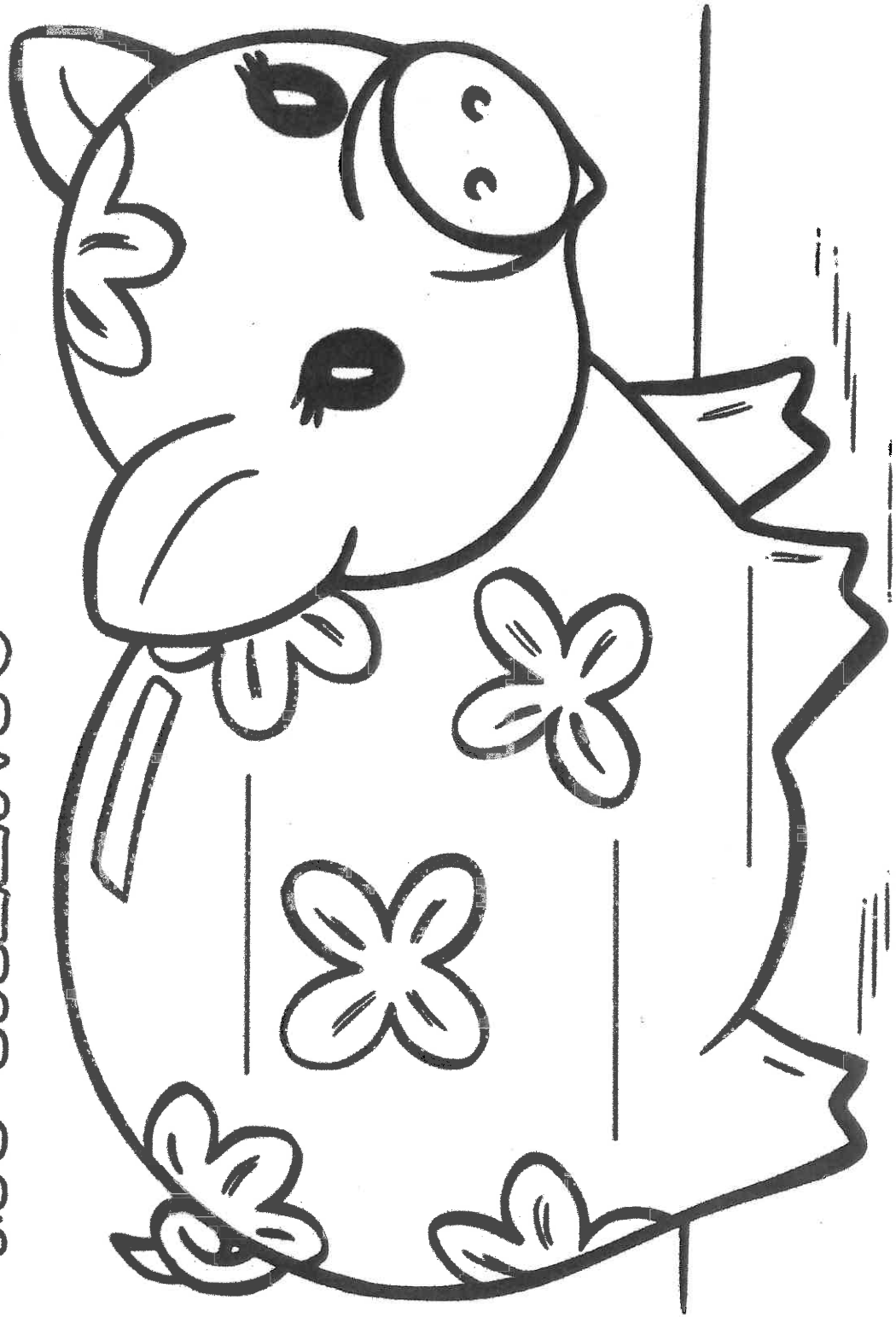

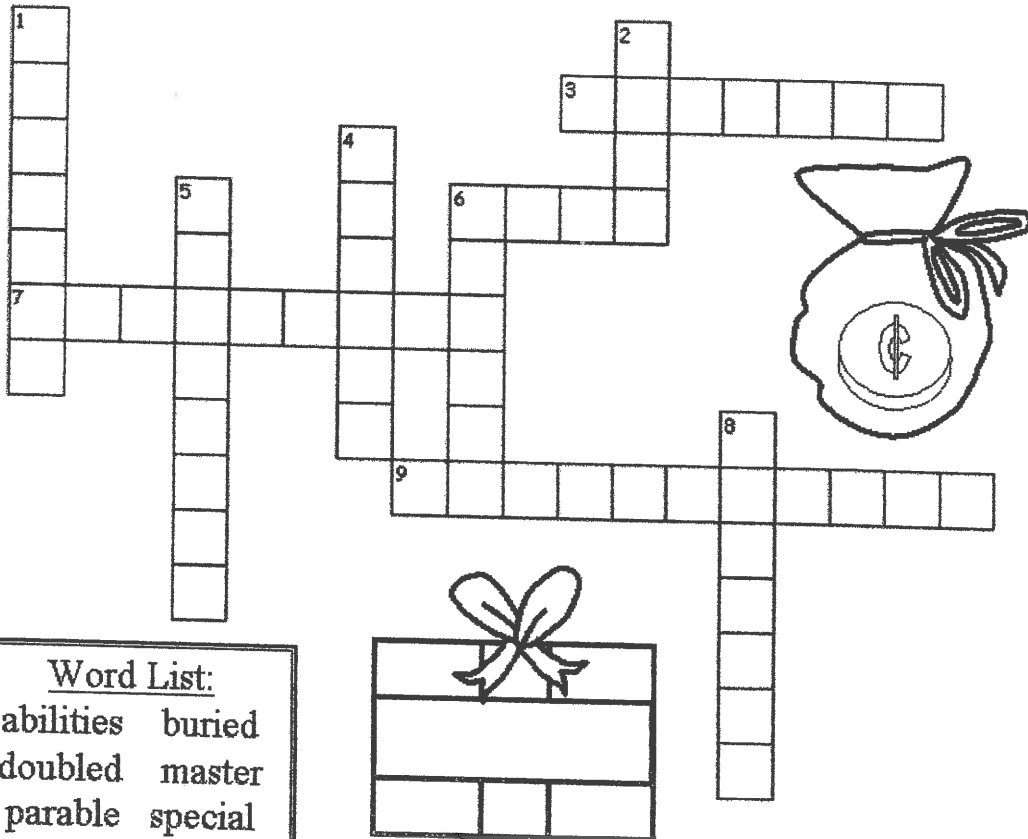

# Parable of the Talents Crossword



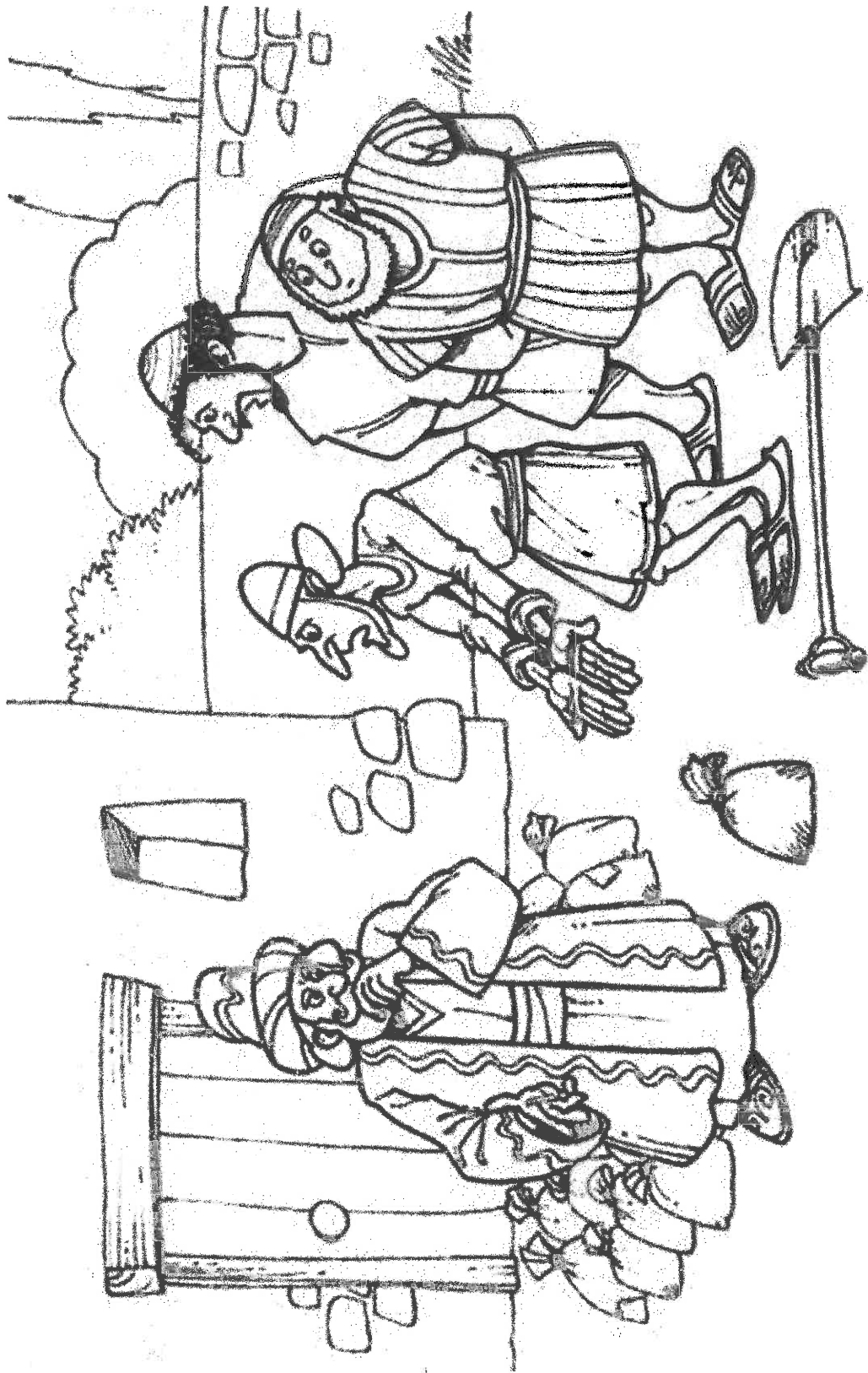

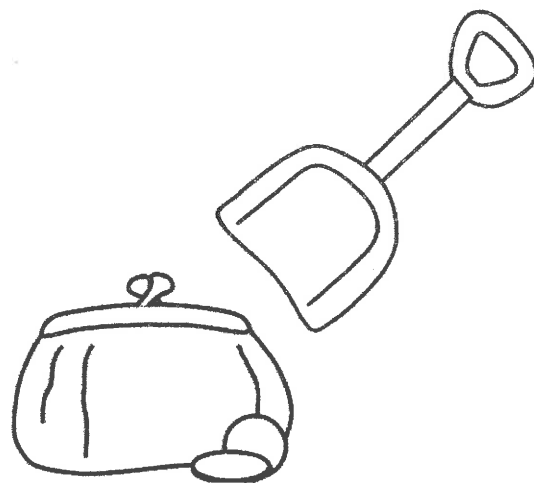

# The Ten Talents

The master gave talents to his servants. He gave the more talents to the one who was his best servant.
